

## What is a mental health carer?

A mental health carer is someone who provides emotional, practical or financial support to someone close to them living with mental illhealth.

A CT Coronary Angiogram is used in patients with low to moderate symptoms of coronary artery disease to visualise blockages in the coronary arteries. Image guided injection of steroid into joints can effectively treat pain

that is limiting your ability to do the things you enjoy.

Specialised injections of anaesthetic and steroid into nerves of the back can offer relief of back pain.

All these services are offered routinely at Perth Radiological Clinic as well as all the usual X-rays, CTs Ultrasounds and MRI.


